

Boldness and Beauty

Landscape architects are currently offered a significant leading role in the development of the landscape. Landscape architecture concretizes how we view our environment and makes our society's relationship with nature visible.

The aim of design has always been to increase well-being. The 19th century was marked by technological advances and engineers played a leading role in developing the industrializing world. In the 20th century, alongside technology and ecology, humanistic values came in discourse; aesthetics and social dimensions. Architects took a central role and set out to solve the challenges of the post-war world.

Now in the 21st century it is landscape architects' turn. The element of nature and the posthumanist perspective add to the goals of design. Traditional design processes go hand in hand with a with a greater understanding of the interaction of technology, man, and nature, and their mutual relationships.

As the operating environment and the issues to be solved its issues become more and more complex; landscape architects have the necessary know-how to coordinate different requirements. The focus of design is increasingly shifting from shaping the end result to leading the entire process, and the landscape architects' profession provides the necessary skills for this.




Boldness

Taking on a socially significant expert role requires courage and responsibility. Until now, the formation of landscape architects' profession has required taking bold action, and now there is a greater need for action than ever before. It is time for landscape architects to take on a leading role in the development of the landscape. Under what conditions can landscape architects act more boldly, and by what means will landscape architects redeem this mandate? How can every landscape architect act boldly in their own work? How do they see their own responsibility in their actions?

Beauty

Aesthetics is one of the cornerstones of landscape architecture. There are now numerous new themes on the design table to solve and coordinate. For this reason, it is timely to ask what is the role of beauty and aesthetics in landscape architecture. The landscape architects' skill to create beauty undoubtedly adds value to landscapes. How can this expertise be used with full advantage? What is the value of beauty in a world of change and crises?



Boldness and Beauty

By bringing these two themes together, the Landscape Architecture Congress 2022 wants to launch an internal identity debate within the profession. Can these boldness and beauty together form the guiding themes for the design of the landscape of the 21st century? Through what examples, design projects, and actions can these themes be defined in landscape architecture? Will one come before the other, or are boldness and beauty prerequisites for each other?

From Airport to hotel with train + tram




(Helsinki-Vantaan lentoasema (Lentokenttä), Lentokenttä, Vantaa – Ruoholahdenranta 3, Helsinki)

1. Buy ABC ticket (4,10 €) from Whim App before getting to the train in the Helsinki-Vantaa Airport.
2. Take train I or P to Helsinki Railway Station.
3. Take tram 7 or 9 to Ruoholahden villat.
4. Walk 100 m to hotel Radisson Blu Seaside (Ruoholahdenranta 3, Helsinki).

From hotel to airport with tram + train

(Ruoholahdenranta 3, Helsinki – Helsinki-Vantaan lentoasema (Lentokenttä), Lentokenttä, Vantaa)

1. Walk 100 m to tram stop Ruoholahden villat.
2. Buy ABC ticket (4,10 €) from Whim App before getting to the tram.
3. Take tram 7 or 9 to Helsinki Railway Station.
4. Take train I or P to Helsinki-Vantaa Airport.





From the hotel to Aalto Campus

(Ruoholahdenranta 3, Helsinki – Aalto University, Otakaari 24, Espoo)

1. Walk 850 m from hotel to Ruoholahti Metro Station.
2. Buy AB ticket (2,8 €) from Whim App before the roller stairs at the metro station.
3. Take any metro to Tapiola/Matinkylä direction (M1 or M2).
4. Leave the metro at Aalto University.
5. Walk 350 m to Aalto Campus.

From Aalto Campus to the hotel

1. Walk 350 m to Aalto University Metro station.
2. Buy AB ticket (2,8 €) from Whim App before the roller stairs at the metro station.
3. Take any metro to Vuosaari/Mellunmäki direction (M1 or M2).




4. Leave the metro at Ruoholahti Metro Station.
5. Walk 850 m to hotel Radisson Blu Seaside.

From Aalto Campus to Restaurant Töölö

From the hotel to Hietsun paviljonki


Walk, use city bike, e-scooter or taxi with Whim App.

Traveling times



- 27 min walking (1,8 km)

- 10 min e-scooter (~ 3-4 €)
- 5 min by taxi (~ 10-20 €)
